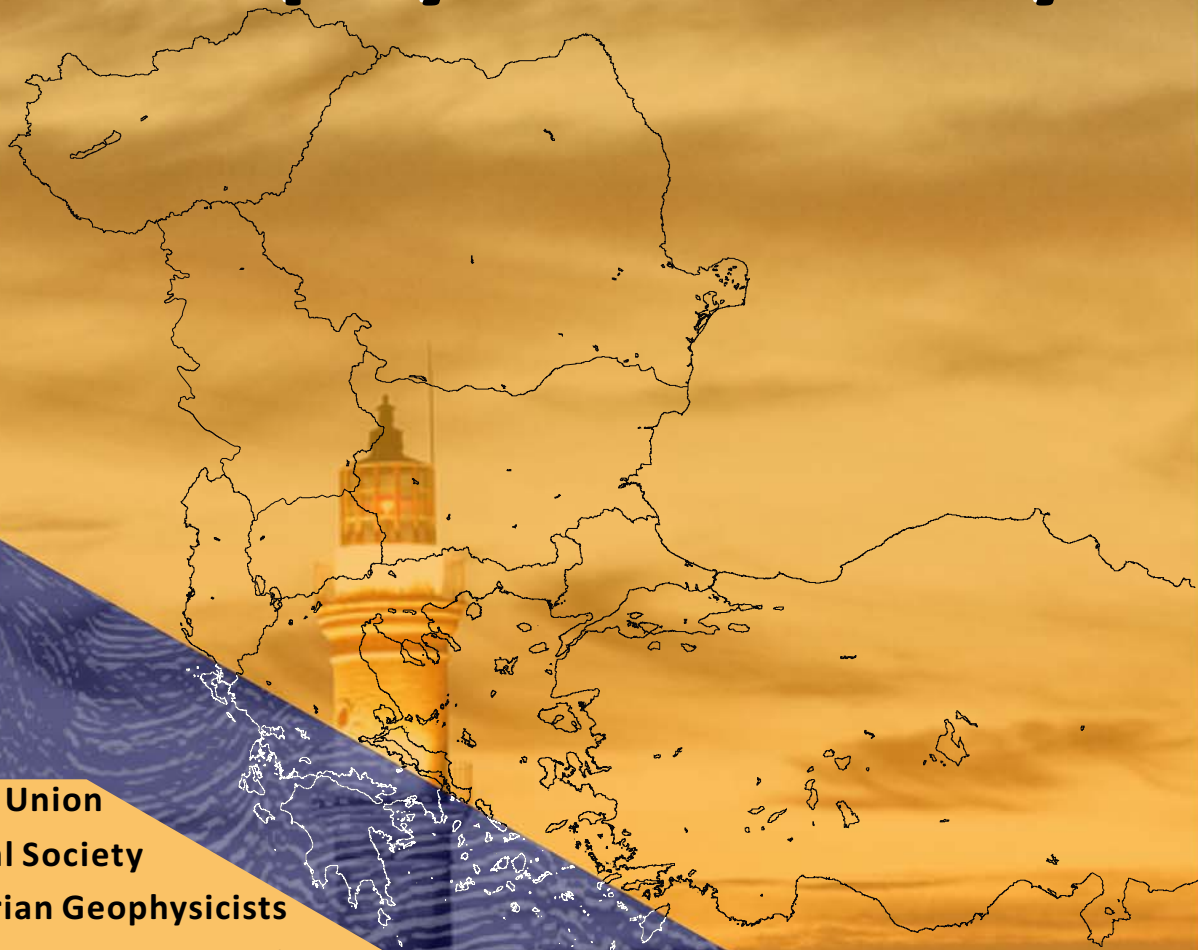

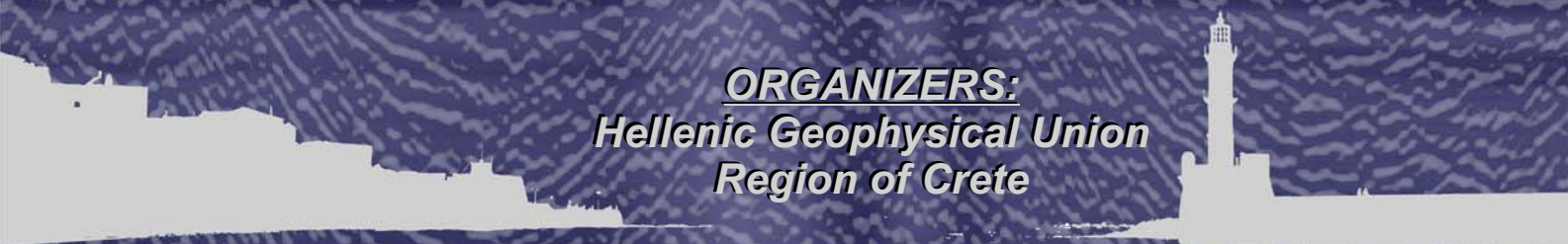

Venue
